

ON SHOW

IN Fremantle, the Beach, Pakenham Street, has a splendid show of black pastel drawings by Stephanie Jones.

Her 24 *Interiors* are dark silhouettes of dresses or slips. Inside each is depicted an interior

scene, from a tea table to a distant spiral staircase.

All have some association with female experience, real or fantasy, Dallas or dish washing. They are beautifully drawn.

Jones is also showing *Drawn from Life*, four details of a lived-in bedroom made to fit the arched recesses along one wall of the gallery.

The first panel simply shows her shoes, the next a chair with clothes draped on it, the third a corner of a bed and a handbag, and the last a clothes rack and hat.

There is something very Japanese about these simple glimpses at the margins of a life.
